QUILEUTE ANNUAL FISHING REGULATION OFF RESERVATION March 18, 2011

FISHERY: Subsistence

TARGET SPECIES: Halibut

MANAGEMENT PERIOD: March 12, 2011 12:00 noon through December 31, 2011 noon

MANAGEMENT AREA: Sand Point 48° 07' 36" N Latitude to Queets River 47° 31' 42" N Latitude

TIME PERIOD: March 20, 2011 through December 31, 2011

SUBSISTENCE LIMIT: 4 halibut per day / per vessel


GEAR RESTRICTIONS: Longline Gear

PARTICIPATING F/V: All vessels

CEREMONIAL & SUBSISTENCE: There is no size limit restriction for C & S Halibut. You must report all C&S take home on fish tickets. During all non-commercial management periods C&S is open year round.

NOTE: This regulation supersedes all previous postings. Operators participating in the halibut fishery shall maintain an accurate log book (Provided by IPHC). Recording of halibut fishing operations is in compliance with federal regulations.
